**NEW GENIE® Z™-51/30J RT DEVELOPED TO MEET THE DEMANDS  
OF THE EUROPEAN MARKET**

*REDMOND, WASH.* (June 29, 2005) – Developed to meet the specific needs of the European market, Genie Industries' new Z-51/30J RT articulating boom will debut at the Platformer Days trade show in Hohenroda/Hessen, Germany, Aug. 19-20, 2005.

“While the Z-45/25 is a popular machine in Europe, our customers requested we develop a unit with more reach and height, higher ground clearance, yet maintain a compact footprint to meet the worksite challenges of the European market,” explained Phil Harvey, product manager for the Genie telescopic and articulating boom line.

The result – the Z-51/30J RT, which provides the consumer with an additional 1.83 m (6 ft) of height without compromising worksite accessibility. Extremely compact, the Z-51/30J RT has a stowed height of 2.16 m (7 ft 1 in), stowed length of 7.5 m (24 ft 6 in), width of 2.29 m (7 ft 6 in) and a centre ground clearance of 0.39 m (15.5 in). The unit features a platform height of 15.6 m (51 ft 3 in), 9.2 m (30 ft 4 in) of horizontal outreach, 7 m (23 ft 1 in) of up-and-over clearance and a lift capacity of 227 kg (500 lb).

To streamline the ordering process, Genie customers requested the Z-51/30J RT be available in one configuration featuring 4-wheel drive, an oscillating axle, a 1.5 m (5 ft) articulating jib boom and a 36 Kw (49 hp) Deutz Diesel F3L 2011F engine.

Genie redesigned the Z-45/25 to meet the structural requirements of the Z-51/30J RT. Both units now share common components, making service and parts easy to manage.

The first units ordered are scheduled to ship in October, 2005. Distribution of the Z-51/30J RT will be to the European market only.
