### Step 1

Turn key switch to platform. Pull emergency stop out.



### Step 2

Go to platform.


Remove the six 1/4-20 bolts from platform box. Power up platform box with emergency stop.





### Step 3

Disconnect joystick.
Wait for 3-4 seconds alarm will sound.
Plug joystick back in.
move to step 4.



### Step 4

Hold controller full stroke each direction for 5-7 seconds.

Note: DO NOT STEP ON FOOT SWITCH. After the second stroke of each joystick the alarm should sound indicating calibration.
