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Tech Tips Safety Rules



Danger

Do Not Perform Maintenance Unless:

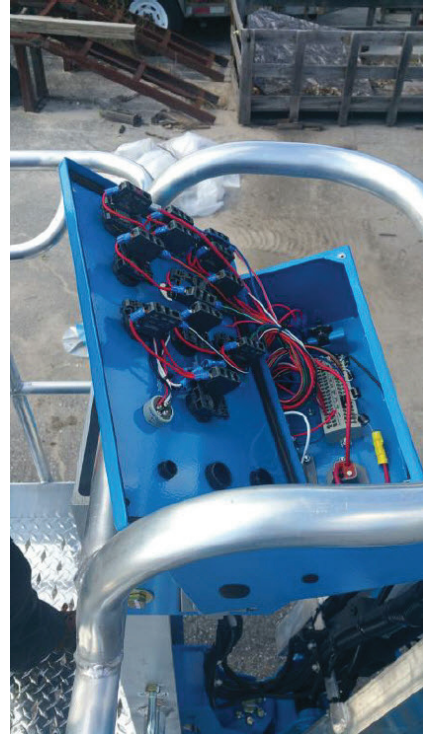
- You are trained and qualified to perform maintenance on this machine.

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Step 1

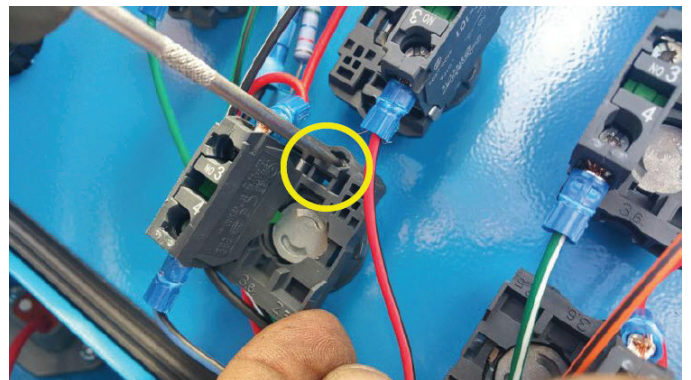
Remove the screws securing the platform control box panel.



Step 2

Remove the contact block from the back of the button by unlocking it with the metal tab, as shown.

Note: Select one button to modify at a time.



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Step 3

Carefully remove the rubber weather boot without damaging it and locate the notch on either side of the button assembly.



Step 4

Using a 1/16" drill bit, slowly drill into the button above the notch.

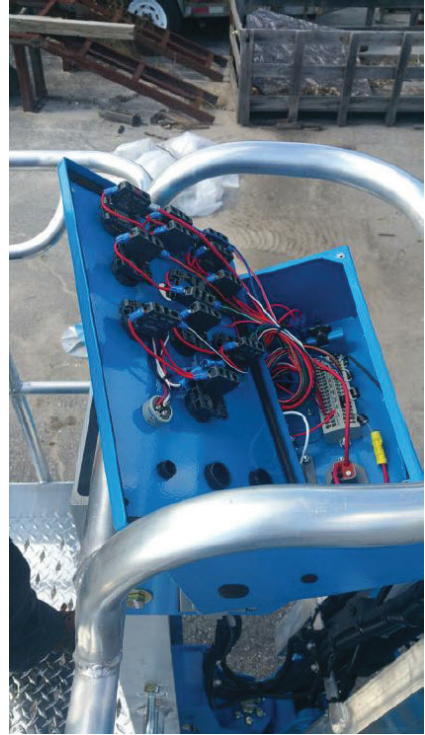
Note: Stop drilling at the point that the drill bit advances. Clean the hole.



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Step 5

Reinstall the rubber weather boot and reinstall the contact block onto the button. Reinstall the button.



Step 6

Repeat steps 2 - 5 for the remaining buttons.



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Step 7

Test all of the functions per the operator's manual. Secure the platform control box cover.
